 1964 Travelled to Greece with his family - lived, painted in Kythera for 1 year
 1965 Arrived in London - worked in Screenprinting, Graphics and Publicity
 1967 26 April - Greek military coup - Involvement with a group working towards the restoration of democracy in Greece, produced posters and banners and raised money for families of political prisoners. Held concerts for fund raising with other artists and performers including John Williams, Melina Mercouri, Janet Suzman, Judy Dench
 1968 Participated in protests and demonstrations against the military coup in Greece
 1970-71 Travelled to Spain, South of France and Morocco
 1971-73 Travelled to Ireland - 3 visits to County Cork
 1974 Returned to Australia
