Within the context of Earth, Water and Sky the 'Divine Garden' series of works are concerned with derivations and aspects of :
Sanctuary, Symmetry, Spirituality, Sensibility, Spatiality, Harmony and Illumination.

'DIVINE GARDEN' series 2010-2011 ed.3
Electrostatic transfer on acid free white coated polyester film.
Acid free adherence onto to mdf board. 380 x 285 mm
(white coated polyester film is tear resistant, water proof, grease proof and does not yellow with age)

General installation instructions for mounted works as below.
[This does not apply to works acquired unmounted]

Work is supplied with 9kg load bearing magnet, screw and raw plug.
Steel washer is affixed at the verso centre point of the work.

Installation is a simple matter of deciding the height at which you wish to hang the work (generally eye height) and then marking the exact central position of each panel if more than one. Spacing of works is variable.
Groupings are normally installed closer together
Drill hole/s at central mark/s for the screw/s or raw plug/s supplied (if brick wall)

Secure the magnet to the wall with supplied screw, making sure the head of the screw fits snugly into the countersunk hole in the magnet and the magnet does not spin.

Don't over tighten the screw or the magnet may crack.
Best to use a hand screwdriver for the last tighten.

When the magnet is secure, place the work centrally on it locating the steel washer over the magnet >>>>>>>>You will notice the attraction!
You may have to jiggle the work a little to ensure that location is central.
